September - October

- Continue to attend University Open Days as applicable. Make use of Personal Statement clinics - visit Careers or Prospects with final draft.
- Register for BMAT and Oxford/Cambridge admissions tests by end of September.
- Applications Music Conservatoires: Internal Deadline mid September.
- Take UKCAT Admissions Test (Medics and Dentists)
- Medics, Vets, Dentists and the Oxbridge internal deadline: You must submit applications to your Personal Tutor by the end of September, to reach UCAS by the mid October.

Autumn

October - November

LNAT admissions test for Law courses: October - November.

- Sit BMAT and Oxford/Cambridge Admissions tests early November.
- Applications to top rank universities: should be submitted to Tutors by the beginning of October.
- Finalising your choice of courses/ institutions and your Personal Statement.
- Attend information session on Alternatives to University: Apprenticeships or College Leaver Training Programmes. Look into Employment options.
- Attend Accountancy and Finance Event
- Higher Education Finance talk (Parents only).

November - December

- Start researching Earn While You Learn College Leaver Training Programmes/ Apprenticeships - in Prospects on Study Directory.
- Mock interviews for Oxford and Cambridge applicants.
- Attend Employer Information Presentations.
- Attend Job Search Sessions on Preparing CV's, Application Forms, Letter's of Application and Cover Letters.
- If you're unsure of Career Plans, book up a Careers Appointment in Prospects.
- All other UCAS applications should be completed asap, College internal deadline: end of November to allow sufficient time to reach UCAS by mid January.

Spring

January - March

- Interested in entering the World of Work: attend Training, Employment and Apprenticeships Recruitment Fair in March.
- UCAS offers start arriving, see Personal Tutors for advice on how to reply to UCAS.
- Continue to attend University Interviews and your choice's Open Days or Post - Application days as applicable.

Summer

April - July

- Final Response from UCAS, you will need to submit your decisions on firm and insurance offers. No UCAS offers? - remember UCAS Extra is worth checking for available courses (opens end of February)
- Entering the World of Work: Continue with Job Search Plan. Finalising any Gap Year Plans.
- Study Leave and start of A2 Exams.
- End of June final deadline for UCAS (late applications). Applications received by this date are processed and sent to universities and colleges. Applications after this date, go directly into clearing.
- Exam Results final confirmation of University places. Support available in Student Services for all students.
