### Date changes

The dates are fixed in so far as we are able, usually 12 months in advance, but there have been occasions where we have had to make some adjustments. This is always done in consultation with students and with notice. Refunds are appropriate if we change the dates and students can no longer participate. We also give inconvenienced students priority in future DofE trips.

### What happens if demand for places is very high?

We will always try to provide for those who wish to do an award but, in the event of numbers exceeding our capacity, names will be entered into a ballot for places. It should be noted that this has not proved necessary in recent years.
