Photo Consent - We love to use pictures of our current students to show what life at Farnborough is like, including for website news stories, social media, advertising and the prospectus! Recent changes in the law mean we now require written consent to use these photos. Please ensure students have set their preferences on CristalWeb. Students can update these preferences at any time by clicking their name in the top right hand corner of CristalWeb and selecting 'Consent Options'.

Lifts to College from parents/guardians - If you bring your child to College, please ensure you drop them off away from the College site and entrances. In particular, do not drop off students in the Staff and Visitor Car Parks on Prospect Avenue or in the Bus Stops on Sand Hill. Traffic wardens patrol these areas. We ask for your cooperation with this to help ease the congestion in the roads around the College.

Car Parking for Second Years - Please advise students not to park in any residential street around the College without a pass. There have been a number of incidents of damage to cars since the start of term.

Absences from College - If students are unable to attend College, we must be notified in one of the following ways:

- phone Main Reception (ideally before 10.30am) on 01252 688200;
- send an email to admin@farnborough.ac.uk; or
- via the Parent Portal

Second year students can record absences on CristalWeb so long as their attendance is above 90%. A reason must be given for their absence and contact is required for each day college is missed. Whilst it is polite for students to contact their teachers to let them know, this is not compulsory and will not authorise the absence. Absences that are not notified are monitored carefully and we will be in contact with parents/guardians if this occurs.
