GENERAL INFORMATION

The College has negotiated with the transport providers to obtain favourable rates for students travelling to College by bus or train. Stagecoach buses offer additional value as these tickets can be used outside College hours, including holidays. However, these prices are not necessarily the best value for some routes. We strongly recommend you research your proposed route of travel to ensure you have good value for money.

Prices for the more popular routes are shown inside this booklet. Prices for other routes can be obtained from Mary Marsh in the Student Services Office. Stagecoach bus passes can be paid for in two instalments (first payment September, second payment December). Flexible payment options are also available please read on for more details.

Surrey Student Bus or Train Fare Card

Fare cards can be purchased directly from Surrey County Council. Application forms need to be downloaded from:

www.surreycc.gov.uk/roads-and-transport/buses-and-trains

The cost is £25 for either a bus or train card. The student can travel on the buses at child fares, alternatively, the train cost would be one third off the adult fare. Replacement tickets cost £10. Information about Train Passes 2018-2019

Designated route term time only. Train tickets are ordered via the Student Services Office at the College.

ASH VALE TO FRIMLEY PASS: £362 per annum

BASINGSTOKE PASS: Basingstoke £883, Hook £625, Winchfield £509 per annum

During peak periods there are up to 4 trains an hour to and from Farnborough. Trains run every half hour throughout the day.

BLACKWATER PASS: £371 per annum

The train service runs regularly throughout the day to Farnborough North station, which is approximately 15/20 minutes walk from the College.

BRACKNELL PASS: £759 per annum

The train service runs regularly throughout the day, changing at Wokingham for Farnborough North station. The College is approximately 15/20 minutes walk from the station.

BROOKWOOD PASS: £421 per annum

There is a regular train service to Farnborough Main Line station. The journey takes a short time and the College is approximately 10 minutes walk from the station.

FLEET PASS: £362 per annum

There is a regular train service between Fleet and Farnborough Main station and takes about 5 minutes. The station is approximately 10 minutes walk from the College.

READING PASS: £1051 per annum

There is a regular train service between Reading and Farnborough North station. The College is approximately 15/20 minutes walk from the station.

WOKINGHAM PASS: Wokingham £616,Crowthorne £472 Sandhurst £454 per annum

There is a regular train service to Farnborough North station. The journey takes a short time and the College is approximately 15/20 minutes walk from the station.

WOKING PASS: £625 per annum

There is a regular train service to Farnborough Main Line station. The journey takes a short time and the College is approximately 10 minutes walk from the station.

Information about Bus Passes 2018-2019

Stagecoach Bus Pass

(Valid for the academic year. Ordered on-line direct from Stagecoach. As per instructions on page 6).

ALDERSHOT Route 1

This service runs every 10 minutes from Aldershot Bus Station to College.

ALDERSHOT/WEYBOURNE Route 418/1

This service will take you to Aldershot Bus Station then the No.1 will bring you to College.

ASH/ASH VALE Route 41/42/1

This service runs from Ash Vale train station to Frimley, then the No.1 will bring you to College.

CAMBERLEY Route 1

This service runs every 10 minutes between Camberley Train Station and College. Travel from the Heatherside area students can use the No. 2 service.

CHOBHAM Route 417

There is one service to College in the morning and then one returning at the end of the College day.

CRONDALL Route 410

This service only operates in the morning and at the end of the College day during term time.

CROWTHORNE Route 494

There is one service to College in the morning and then one returning at the end of the College day.

ELVETHAM HEATH Route 409

This service departs the Heath from Ulric House in the morning and one service at the end of College. During the day the No 10 runs to Fleet Train Station.

FARNHAM Route 404/405

These services offer various options to travel into College throughout the morning and again at the end of College. There is also a lunchtime service.

FINCHAMPSTEAD

Route 406

This service begins at California Rate Payers Hall, travels through Finchamptead, Fleet Hill, Eversley Lower Common, Eversley Cross through to College.

FLEET Route 409/410/10

These services offer various options to travel into College throughout the morning and again at the end of College.

FROGMORE

Route 406/408/494

These services run directly to College in the morning and depart at various times during the afternoon.

HARTLEY WINTNEY Route 408

This service runs directly to College in the morning and has two departure times during the afternoon.

HOOK Route 408

This service runs directly to College in the morning and has two departure times during the afternoon.

ODIHAM Route 408

This service runs directly to College in the morning and has two departure times during the afternoon.

SANDHURST Route 494

There is one service to College in the morning and then one returning at the end of the College day.

WRECCLESHAM

Route 404/405

These services offer two time options in the morning, plus a lunchtime service and has two departure times during the afternoon.

YATELEY

Route 406/408

These services offer various options to travel to College in the morning and depart at various times during the afternoon.

Stagecoach bus passes: Allows students unlimited travel on all Stagecoach buses.

These should be purchased on line and are available from 8 August 2018.

To order on line: log onto www.stagecoachbus.com then into

"Buy your ticket online" and pick Unirider from the first drop down menu, then Farnborough from the next drop down menu and finally

Farnborough Sixth Form College from the last drop down. Then proceed, selecting the correct details.

When ordering you will need to:

- Know your College ID number (Log In No.—last five digits)
- Have a debit or credit card with you

You will be sent your Stagecoach pass. You must always show your College ID card with your bus pass.

Bus Pass Flexible Payments: Alternatively you can pay for your bus pass in 6 equal payments, payable at the beginning of each half term. Bus passes are only valid per half term. This has to be applied for directly through the **Student Services Office** at College.

Train passes: These can be purchased in advance and can be ordered from the Student Services Office **FROM 8 AUGUST 2018.** A photograph and payment must accompany your application form before your pass can be ordered. Please allow 7-10 working days for rail passes to be processed. Tickets **must** be collected from the Students Services Office. Rail passes are valid for the whole term including weekends and Reading Weeks. Tickets can only be used on specified routes when travelling to and from College. Tickets are issued in 3 stages: August, December & March.

Train Pass Flexible Payments: Alternatively you can pay for your train pass termly, please contact Student Services for the individual route prices, or see College website. First payment is due after **8 August** to ensure the ticket will be available for September, second payment will be due from week commencing **3 December** and final payment will be due from week commencing **18 March 2019**.

Replacement passes: Details are available from the Student Services Office.

Stagecoach cost £25.00

• Train cost £10.00 (**only one per academic year**)

Train Tickets: Refunds for train tickets can be applied for through Student Services. Tickets need to be returned to Student Services when applying for a refund. Please note this can sometimes take over 12 weeks. **Refunds will only be given up to the end of the Spring Term.**

Stagecoach Bus Tickets: Although a refund for these tickets has to be applied for direct to Stagecoach, the refund rate/information and form can be obtained from the Student Services Office.
