## Start of Term September 2019

### **Enrolment for new students** 27, 28 and 29 August

### **Induction for new students** Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 September

New students will attend College on one of these days. Appointment slots are given out at enrolment.

### **Term starts for second year students** Thursday 5 and Friday 6 September

Temporary timetables will be available on CristalWeb for these two days. There is an independent study at home day on **Monday 9 September** then your new timetable will operate from 9:00am on **Tuesday 10 September**.

### **Start of term for new students** Monday 9 September

Second year students will continue lessons with your new timetable. All students attend College on these days.

# Important Information and Reminders

## Lanyards & ID Cards

Students are required to wear their lanyard and ID card **at all times** whilst on the College site. If you have forgotten your lanyard, a temporary one can be borrowed for a fee from Student Services.

Lost or damaged lanyards can be replaced for £5. Lost or damaged ID cards can be replaced for £5.

Please go to the Registry office in the Bagnall building to purchase replacements.

## Parking Permits

Parking permits will be available to purchase for second years only from 10 September. A link to purchase a permit will go on the CristalWeb homepage on 10 September. Please follow the instructions carefully. Student Services will need to see your driving licence and valid certificate of insurance.

The prices for the academic year are as follows:

- Student car park - £100
- Road Bays - £80
- Football Ground - £60

When purchasing the permit you will need to be wearing your lanyard - a temporary one will not be accepted. You must also ensure that you do not have any outstanding lanyard fines.

We kindly ask all students not to park in any residential streets around the College without a permit. Please park considerately and leave plenty of time for your journey. We expect all students to be considerate and polite to members of the local community.

## Bus

Stagecoach bus passes can be purchased from 7 August 2019 in one of the following ways:

**Annual bus pass** - total of £655 direct from Stagecoach website:

**Annual bus pass in two instalments - Instalment 1** - £328  
(payment due in September)

**Instalment 2** - £328  
(payment due in December)

**Half termly bus pass** - purchased directly from Student Services each half term. First payment of £110 followed by five payments of £109.

## Train

**\*\* New for 2019: 16-17 Railcard \*\***

Coming soon - a new railcard offering a 50% discount for 16 and 17 year olds. Information will be put on the College website as soon as it is available.

Alternatively, train passes can be purchased from Student Services from 7 August 2019. Please complete the train application form (available from Student Services) and send it in with a passport sized photograph and payment. Please allow approximately 10 working days for train passes to be processed.
